## MacBook Specifications

- All models of Apple laptop (MacBook, MacBook Air, MacBook Pro) are currently acceptable for use at HIS.
  - hard drive (HDD)/flash drive (SSD) is greater than 256 GB
    - \*Macs with SD Card Slot can purchase an extension card of 128 GB for around 400 RMB and this counts part of the internal HDD/SDD drive.
  - age of the laptop at the start of the school year is less than 3 1/2 years old

#### Recommended Accessories



Laptop Carry Bag - HIS strongly recommends that each student have a sturdy laptop carry bag or case to protect their laptop during travel to/from school

USB Hard Drive - HIS strongly recommends that parents purchase a 1 TB or larger external USB Hard Drive for exclusive use with each laptop. Students can use Apple Time Machine software, which comes with the laptop, to easily backup their data. USB Hard Drives are readily available at the <u>Solution Keys website</u> and most stores that sell computers.



SD Card - can be purchased for around 400 RMB to expand 128 GB.

 Purchase/provide a family laptop, and optional laptop bag, and external USB hard drive that the student will use at HIS on a daily basis. (Set the administrator for the laptop. Parents of students should supervise their student as s/he sets up his/her own administrator account on the laptop.



• Set up an Apple ID. Parents of students under 13 years of age should use Apple Family Sharing to set up an Apple ID for use in installing necessary software. Parents of older students may use Apple Family Sharing or supervise their student as s/he sets up his/her own Apple ID. (The FAQ below provides recommendations and helpful information on how to set up the Apple ID.)



 Register the laptop at the HIS Tech
 Pagoda during Student Orientation, or another day if more convenient.



Note: For the student's success within the laptop program, we strongly recommend that parents do not let their student use the laptop until after establishing usage rules and boundaries. 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#### Family Technology Plan

This document is designed to facilitate discussion about technology use in the home and to help families develop and outlines rules and expectations.

Talk about WHEN and WHERE technology is used.

Establish places where it is appropriate to use technology - family spaces, bedroom, dinner table. Think about how much time should be spent with technology. Ask yourselves, "How can we balance technology use with other activities, homework, and sleep time?"

#### HIS Recommends That:

- All devices are used only in an open area where the screen is visible to an adult. Children should not be on a device in a room with the door closed.
- Families decide on a time when all devices are turned OFF for the night.
- Families designate a place outside a child's room where all technology devices are charged overnight.

#### **OUR PLAN**

We talked about WHERE technology should be used at home and WHEN it should not be used. We agree to:

Talk about HOW technology will be used and monitored.

Establish ways to maintain open and honest communication about how children use technology. Have a plan for deciding what software and apps are appropriate for your child and how much time (if any) will be allowed for gaming/entertainment. If you allow video games to be installed, use the video game ratings to decide which games are okay to play.
