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The School and Community

Hangzhou International School (HIS) is a non-profit, co-educational, inclusive day school established in 2002 to serve the children of foreign nationals in Grades EY-12 (ages 2-18). HIS is governed by a self-perpetuating Board of Directors and overseen by the International School Foundation (ISF). The 20,000m2 campus is home to over 760 students with 160 students in the high school. Our students come from over 50 different nationalities and speak over 30 mother tongue languages.

The HIS Mission

The HIS mission is to provide international learners with opportunities to pursue academic and personal excellence in a caring community.

Accreditation and Authorization

Hangzhou International School (HIS) is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and is authorized as an IB Continuum School by the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) to offer the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and Diploma Programme (DP). All upper school students in Grades 6-12 follow IB MYP and DP coursework and the majority pursue the full IB Diploma. All qualifying students also receive an accredited HIS High School Diploma. The school year is divided into two semesters, running from August to December and January to June for 180 instructional days.

Students must complete at least 4 credits of English Language A or B. Additional language and literature credits may be earned in other languages. Students must also complete non-credit Creativity, Action, & Service (CAS), Extended Essay (EE) or Senior Project, and graduation portfolio/presentation requirements

Assessment

HIS offers standardized assessments to prepare for college entrance exams. HIS is an exam center for the SAT and PSAT. Students regularly score above the global average. Faculty use IB criteria and rubrics to assess student attainment levels. External moderation validates the evaluation.

IB Diploma Program (IBDP)

The IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) is a two-year preuniversity program which consists of six subjects (three at Higher Level and three at Standard Level), an Extended Essay (EE) of 4000 words, a Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course, and a required Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) component.

The IBDP is structured to provide students with a rigorous and balanced education, to facilitate geographic and cultural mobility, and to promote international understanding.



IBDP Results, Grades and Class Rank

HIS reports student achievement on assessments that are graded against clearly expressed criteria and rubrics. All assessment grades are reported using a 1-7 scale with a 3 being the minimum passing grade to receive credit. HIS does not provide a class rank for individual students and does not weight grades. Grade Point Averages (GPA) are not used for final calculations. The IB Diploma results for the last three years are posted below.

Technology Access

HIS is a 1:1 Macbook school, using student laptops with school wifi coverage and online research access. The ManageBac platform allows for digital submission and documentation of student work, assessment, and communication.

Awards and Recognitions

Students at HIS are recognized with Principal's Honor Roll for achievement each semester. At the end of the year, faculty nominate students for HIS Community Awards including categories such as Inquirer, Communicator, Principled & Caring, Self-Management, and Perseverance. Students are also recognized for participation and achievement in athletics each year. Coaches recognize top players with yearly awards.

China Trip Explorations

Students at HIS participate in a yearly trip to different locations in China, including Guizhou, Inner Mongolia, and Yunnan provinces. They take part in community service projects, challenge themselves physically while exploring the different terrains of rural communities, and gain insight to the language and culture of the country. These curricular programs provide excellent opportunities for exploration and introduction to our host country culture.

HIS Extra Curricular Activities

HIS offers a wide range of extracurricular activities, sports, and creative programs to promote student development. Students take part in organizations such as Model United Nations, Global Issues Network, Student Council, Upper School Musical Ensemble, National Honor Society and more. Students also coordinate their own activities such as Cooking Club, Robotics Club, Chess Club, etc. Students are involved in service projects to area children's hospitals, environmental sites, and local organizations. Students help plan the annual Dragon Run 5k, which supports the migrant school Library Project through fundraising.

HIS Dragon Athletics

HIS Dragons are part of the ACAMIS, SISAC, SSL and HISAC athletic associations, allowing for competitive matches around China. Student athletes gain teamwork and leadership skills while taking top rank in local and regional tournaments. Varsity and junior-varsity sports include Badminton, Basketball, Soccer, Swimming, Table Tennis, Golf and Volleyball.
